Agenda Item 1 – Call to Order

Meeting called to order at 5:31 pm by J. Grabowski inviting participation in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion made by J. Grabowski, seconded Miller, to appoint Trustee Ed Hill as Committee Chair. Motion passed unanimously

Agenda Item 2 – Minutes of December 7, 2021 meeting

M. Grabowski moved, second Wunsch to approve Minutes of the December 7, 2021 Public Works and Safety Committee as presented. Motion passed 4-0, Nichols, Wellenstein, J. Grabowski abstained.

Agenda Item 3 – Citizen Comments

Cheryl Mantz, 315 Cardinal Ridge, discussed road signage and condition of prospect Avenue from Lake Street to School Street needs improvements, especially pedestrian signs. Ms Mantz indicated she met with the Police Chief to discuss children crossing Prospect, and asked for more signs and pavement marking.

Agenda Item 4 – Old Business

- a. Discussion and Action Regarding Previous Recommendation - Ordinance 2021-09 – Amending Chapter 86, Article III, Division 3, Section 86.114 of the Village of Pewaukee Code of Ordinances Regarding No Parking Designation, on the South Side of Oakton Avenue From, and East, of the Pewaukee River

Director Naze stated this is returning for additional discussion and a proposed solution. Discussion followed regarding a best option for restricting parking on the south side of the street at 200 Oakton. Motion J. Grabowski, second M. Grabowski, recommending to the Village Board to repeal and recreate ordinance 2021-09, to restrict no parking from the Pewaukee River east bridge deck to the first driveway to the east. DPW direction is to install signage and paint curb. Motion passed unanimously.

Agenda Item 5 - New Business

- a. Water System Master Plan - Presentation of Draft Report, with Possible Forwarding Recommendation to the Village Board.

Don Heikkila from Ruekert Mielke was introduced to present the findings of the Water System Master Plan. Following discussion, Motion M. Grabowski, second Wunsch, to forward the report to the Village Board, where a similar presentation will be made. Motion passed unanimously.

- b. 2022 Sanitary Survey Report, Wisconsin DNR

Director Naze briefly described the triannual sanitary survey process, contents of the report, past recommendations and the recommendation for 2022, which was to ensure staffing is adequate. Informational only, no action taken.

- c. Striping of crosswalks on main street along the lakefront.

Item brought forward by J. Grabowski. Discussion followed with direction given and acknowledged to staff to paint enhanced crosswalk markings for 2022. No motion.

- d. Exploration of costs to add raised pedestrian crossings at the three lakefront crossings. Possible action to approve DPW to receive proposals.

Item tabled for future discussion

- e. Cutting grass along Capitol Dr under Highway 16 between the on/off ramps. Possible action to notify Waukesha County that Village will maintain.

Item brought forward by J. Grabowski, discussion followed on jurisdiction and County responsibilities. DPW is now flail mowing the area at the frequency of other mowing, three to four times a year. It was requested to perform additional flail mowing when time permits.

- f. Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) Grant Program

Time constraints resulted in only brief discussion of this program, regarding where need may be and engaging a consultant to prepare an application. No action.

Date: July 14, 2022
Re: Discussion and Action - Presentation of Draft 10-Year Infrastructure Capital Improvement Program.

Attached are draft 10-year capital improvement project listings and a proposed capital equipment schedule. The project listing is presented two ways; grouped by utility, and a page with all items I have listed comprehensively by project. I have recently added several projects that were either recommended in the draft water study report and/or are likely to be proposed or necessary as part of our well #2 gross alpha exceedance response to the Department of Natural resources. Building facility needs have not yet been compiled in a report and are not included in this plan.

Committee should review and if appropriate, amend, add, delete, consider project years, and evaluate resources available and sustainability of what I have recommended. In addition, my project estimates are based on past years construction cost data, and I suggest that a compounded inflation factor be applied to the values provided and ask for direction on what that value should be. To the best of current predictions, we tried to anticipate the future cost of equipment in these estimates.

This CIP plan is the road map for the next 2 to 5 years to conduct municipal borrowing, set utility rates, meet regulatory requirements, and apply for funds such as the Local Road Improvement Program which requires a 5-year road plan in the application. CIP plans should always be considered dynamic as needs change during its implementation.

Recommendation:

Direction to staff as indicated above for further action by the Administrator and Village Board.

The former location of 15-minute parking zones of existing code was predicated on the location of the former “Cakes While U Wait” bakery located in the proximity of the parking stalls. Beach Bum Bakery is a new bakery located further north of the former bakery and would like to have the 15-minute parking stalls properly located by Village Code in proximity to their bakery. Existing code indicates:

(c)No person shall park any vehicle, or permit any vehicle to be parked, or to remain parked, for more than 15 minutes on the east side of West Wisconsin Avenue in the southern two parking stalls of the twelve-stall grouping to the north of the grass island located approximately 440 feet north of the intersection of West Wisconsin Avenue and Oakton Avenue.

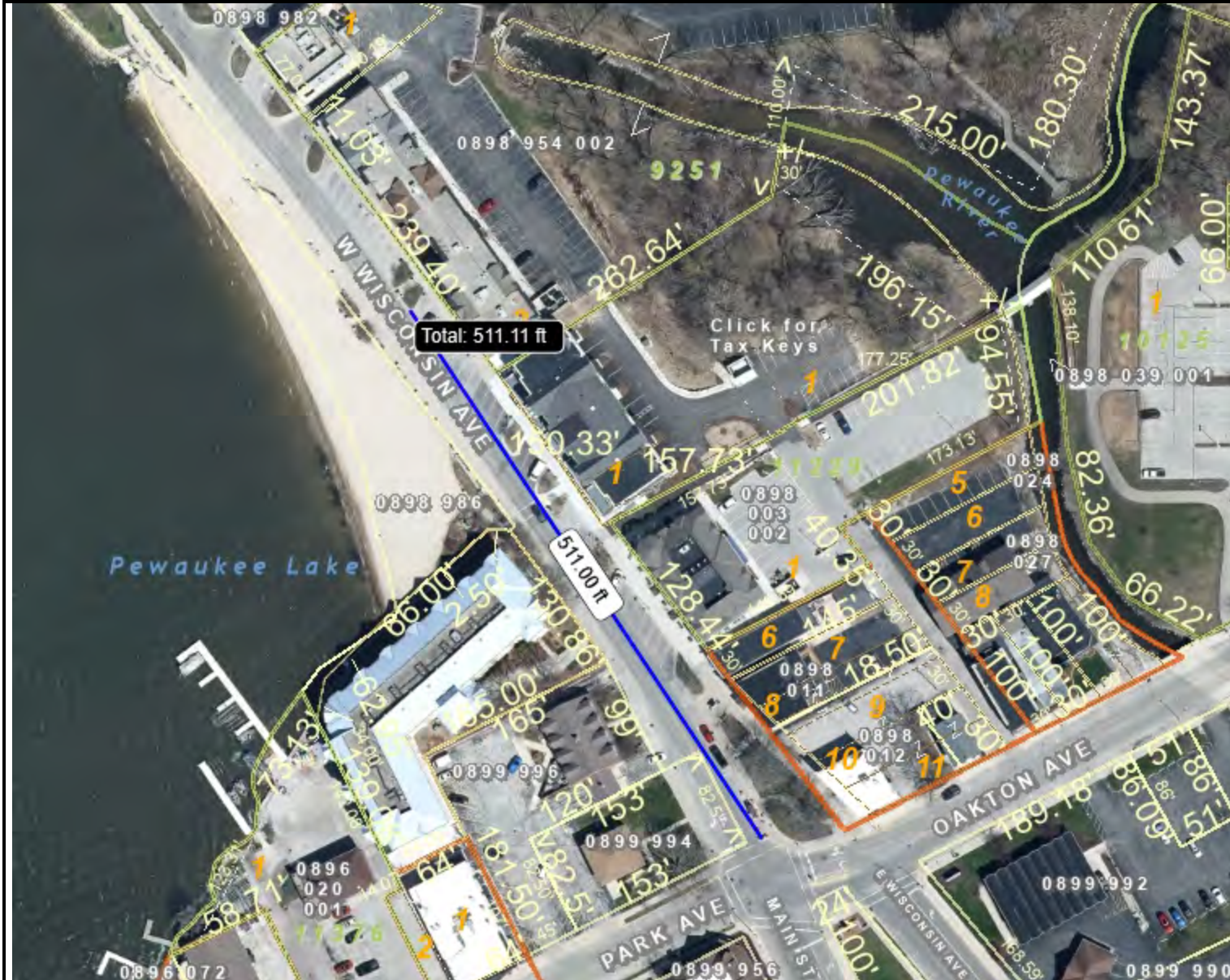
Amended Form:

Subdivision VII – Restricted Parking - Section 86.119.5(c) – Specific Areas:

No person shall park any vehicle, or permit any vehicle to be parked, or to remain parked, for more than 15 minutes on the east side of West Wisconsin Avenue in the northern two parking stalls of the twelve-stall grouping to the south of the grass island located approximately 508 feet north of the intersection of West Wisconsin Avenue and Oakton Avenue.

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-09

ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 86.119.5(C) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF PEWAUKEE

The Village Board of the Village of Pewaukee, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE: Section 86.119.5(c) of the Municipal Code of the Village of Pewaukee is amended to read as follows:

Section 86.119.5(c): TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES, SUBDIVISION VII – RESTRICTED PARKING;

(c) No person shall park any vehicle, or permit any vehicle to be parked, or to remain parked, for more than fifteen (15) minutes on the east side of West Wisconsin Avenue in the ~~southern~~northern two parking stalls of the twelve stall grouping to the ~~south~~north of the grass island located approximately ~~440~~508 feet north of the intersection of West Wisconsin Avenue and Oakton Avenue.

SECTION TWO: The several sections of this Ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section, sub-section or paragraph of this Ordinance shall be declared by a decision of a Court of Competent Jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of other provisions of this Ordinance or the section of which the invalid portion or paragraph may be a part.

SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication as provided by law.
