VILLAGE RESOLUTION #2020-22
APPROVING THE JOINT PARKS AND
RECREATION COMPREHENSIVE PLAN
OF THE CITY & VILLAGE OF PEWAUKEE, WISCONSIN
DATED DECEMBER, 2020


- WHEREAS, the Village and City of Pewaukee established the Pewaukee Joint Parks and Recreation Board (the "Board") in January 1997.
- WHEREAS, the Board agreed to update/revise the *2006 Addendum to the Joint Comprehensive Park and Open Space Plan*;
- WHEREAS, the Board's objectives for the plan include the following: (1) to have for reference and information for the on-going administration of their duties as a Board, a plan that will serve to build on an existing base of recreation and park facilities but will additionally consider and accommodate proper planning for the substantial population growth that the community of Pewaukee has experienced since the late 1980's; and to have a plan that speaks to current trends and community desires for the provision of specific kinds of recreation facilities, parks and open space and (2) to position the Village and City of Pewaukee for submittal of funding applications for various grant programs to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources for at least the next five years;
- WHEREAS, after an objective and impartial review/evaluation of community needs, public input via surveys, and significant effort by the Board, staff and others, a plan has been developed which addresses the Board's objectives.
- WHEREAS, this plan is in the best interest of and will benefit the citizens of the Village and City of Pewaukee for years to come;
- THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Village Board of the Village of Pewaukee and the Common Council of the City of Pewaukee hereby approve the Joint Parks and Recreation Comprehensive Plan of the City & Village of Pewaukee.
