Plans are underway on developing a concept for the use of the piers for transient slips to allow people wanting to utilize the downtown businesses and events. No overnight mooring would be allowed. Other ideas are being looked at for the balance of the piers.

The Village is looking at different ways and ideas to help with lake weed pick up. We have reached out to the Lake Pewaukee Sanitary District to see if there are any options for a possible contract with them.
