**Noticed your rates went up?** The costs of the treatment plant for sewer discharge have significantly increased over the last couple of years. Both the sanitary sewer and transportation utility budgets have increased due to repayment of debt for the new Public Works Facility. The increase in our storm water utility fees is due to major projects related to roads which will be paid for on a cash basis, in lieu of borrowing funds.
