RECYCLING CENTER

Recyclables are accepted free of charge for all Waukesha County residents.

- Bottles
- Cans
- Newspaper
- Cardboard
- Used Motor Oil
- Transmission Fluid
- Antifreeze
- Oil Filters

Cardboard must be broken down.



YARD WASTE

Yard waste disposal is ONLY allowed for RESIDENTS of the Village of Pewaukee.

A \$35 display tag is required for any resident who wishes to drop off their yard waste or brush.

The display tag is valid for the current year only and may be purchased at the Village Hall.

Tags must be purchased prior to disposing of yard waste.

If you lose your tag, you will be required to purchase another one.

- Grass Clippings
- Branches no larger than 6" diameter and 6' long
- Leaves




