Wis. Stat. § 6.875, "Absentee voting in certain residential care facilities and retirement homes." Wisconsin law mandates that absentee voting inside residential care facilities and qualified retirement homes must be conducted *by municipalities* using Special Voting Deputies (SVDs).

The rate of pay is **\$7.25 per hour** for Election Inspectors and **\$8.25 per hour** for Chief Inspectors. Training is required for all election inspectors prior to being scheduled to work at the polls on Election Day. Polls are open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day. Election Inspectors are typically scheduled in 8-hour shifts between 6:30 a.m. and when all paperwork is completed after the polls close (after 8:00 p.m.) Additional shifts available are in-person absentee voting and Special Voting Deputies at Care Facilities.
