Are you interested in becoming a Special Voting Deputy (SVD)? YES  NO

Wis. Stat. § 6.875, "Absentee voting in certain residential care facilities and retirement homes." Wisconsin law mandates that absentee voting inside residential care facilities and qualified retirement homes must be conducted by municipalities using Special Voting Deputies (SVDs).

The rate of pay is **\$7.25 per hour** for Election Inspectors and **\$8.25 per hour** for Chief Inspectors. Training is required for all election inspectors prior to being scheduled to work at the polls on Election Day. Polls are open from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Election Day. Election Inspectors are typically scheduled in 8-hour shifts between 6:30 a.m. and when all paperwork is completed after the polls close (after 8:00 p.m.) Additional shifts available are in-person absentee voting and Special Voting Deputies at Care Facilities.
