NEW CRUISING ORDINANCE

Cruising Definition



Driving a motor vehicle past a Traffic Control Point on a highway in the Designated Area more than twice in any two-hour period between the hours of 11:00 am and 11:00 pm between May 1 and October 31 in a manner and under circumstances manifesting a purpose of unnecessary, repetitive driving.

Purpose of Ordinance

To reduce the following which directly result from cruising in the downtown and lakefront area: dangerous traffic congestion, noise, and air pollution; obstruction of streets, sidewalks, and parking lots; impediment of access to business during peak hours of lakefront and downtown area use; interference with access for emergency vehicles to and through the said highways.
